**Henderson Christian Community Outreach**, 422 7th Street, Henderson, KY 42420. Their Phone# is: (270) 826-5592. Services offered include utility assistance up to \$100 with cut off notice, rent assistance up to \$100 with eviction notice, first month's rent or emergency lodging, prescription assistance for life threatening purposes, food pantry assistance on an every 30 day basis, dental assistance up to \$100 on an every 6 months basis and emergency transportation assistance. For assistance, you will need photo ID, SS# at each visit. Face to face interview with assistance dependent upon availability of funds and pantry items.



**Matthew 25, Food Pantry - Zack's Kitchen**, 452 Old Corydon Road, Henderson, KY 42420. Monday and Friday only, 10 a.m. – 4 p.m. Zack's Kitchen is a food pantry named in memory of a special friend of Matthew 25's who was killed in a car accident at the age of 24. The pantry is stocked with canned goods, personal care items, household cleaning products, paper products, and frozen meat. Clients can receive items twice a month. Care is given to offer nutritional food as well as personal items that are often hard for clients to purchase. Our goal is for our food pantry to *supplement* the client's food supply. Zack's is staffed by volunteers.
